However, the global COVID-19 pandemic has forced many businesses and operations to shut down in an effort to preserve the health and safety of our communities. Given the current surge of cases around the country and the deep level of uncertainty as to when it will be safe to resume social gatherings, BWRAG has decided to cancel the remainder of our 2020 summit schedule.

To that end, we're now building out an 8-Part Online "Surf Responder" Course. We will also be working on building out our 2021 summit schedule, in hopes that community activities are deemed safe by that point.

Given the cancellation of our entire 2020 summit schedule, BWRAG is working tirelessly to find ways to keep its operations going so that you can continue to receive meaningful, useful content and ocean safety training.
